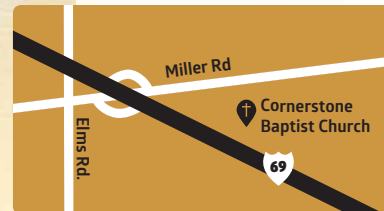

Upward Sports (Kindergarten–6th Grade)
